

It's crucial to see the big picture.

The big picture is that elite Maori want to take over control of New Zealand.

They want to get their hands on our country's assets and cash.

I am literally stunned that very few commentators / broadcasters / bloggers / media outlets talk in terms of the big picture. They are just not seeing it.

Rather, they get bogged down in the detail.

Of course, in one sense they have to, because they want to create discussion and debate. This improves their ratings.

Let's take the 3 Waters Bill for example. There are literally hundreds of aspects / parts to this Bill.

I would agree that any Bill must articulate the detail, and be clear, so that everyone understands / knows how the Bill, whatever it is, is going to affect people.

After all, whatever Bill is being discussed / debated, it's ultimately about the people of New Zealand.

Detail versus the Big Picture.

The big picture sees the motive, the overall plan. The big picture joins the dots. The big picture flies above the clouds, looking down to get the macro view.

Look at the picture below right.

Some people just see a young glamorous woman. Others see an old hag.

Both images are in the same picture. This is just like what is happening in New Zealand.

Let's say the old hag represents the detail, and the young glamorous woman represents the big picture.

I want people to see both. If you can't see both, keep looking!  
That's the point. They are both in this single picture. It's an optical illusion.

I want people to see both the detail and the big picture. Both are important.

But of the two, the big picture is most important.

Why?

It alerts us to the seriousness of our national situation. As I said, in New Zealand, there is an attempted coup going on. Elite Maori are having a crack at taking over. Ardern and Robertson are



funding this.

This thought ought to massively motivate everyone to stand up and fight. Why?

Because if they are successful, we are going to rapidly slip into becoming a third world country. How so? All the good people will see what's coming (i.e. tribal rule) and will leave. Only the riff raff will stay.

**Never lose sight of the bigger picture.**

What happens next?
