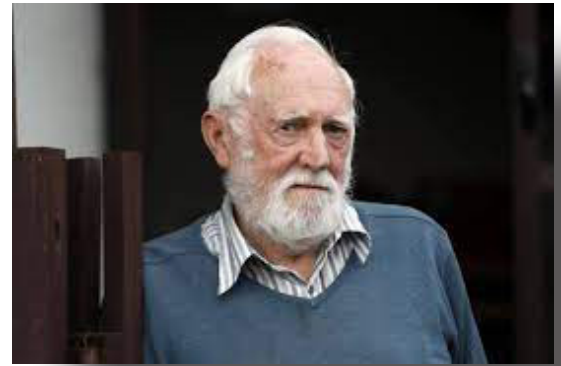


*The Waitangi Tribunal has recommended that Northland be given to Maori. But on what basis?*

*The following is the Waitangi Tribunal's summary, in five points, word for word, of its conclusions in stage 1 of the Northland Inquiry. Bruce's comments are in red.*



1.

*“The rangatira who signed te Tiriti o Waitangi in February 1840 did not cede their sovereignty to Britain. That is, they did not cede authority to make and enforce law over their people or their territories.”*

*This is a straight falsehood which treats the actual evidence with contempt.*

2.

*“The rangatira agreed to share power and authority with Britain. They agreed to the Governor having authority to control British subjects in New Zealand, and thereby keep the peace and protect Maori interests.”*

*This is another straight falsehood.*

3.

*“The rangatira consented to the treaty on the basis that they and the Governor were to be equals, though they were to have different roles and different spheres of influence. The detail of how this relationship would work in practice, especially where the Maori and European populations intermingled, remained to be negotiated over time on a case-by-case basis.”*

*This is the Tribunal's third straight falsehood.*

4.

*“The rangatira agreed to enter land transactions with the Crown, and the Crown promised to investigate pre-treaty land transactions and to return any land that had not been properly acquired from Maori.*

*This is true.*

5.

*“The rangatira appear to have agreed that the Crown would protect them from foreign threats and represent them in international affairs, where that was necessary. Though Britain we went into the treaty negotiation intending to acquire sovereignty, and therefore the power to make and enforce law over both Maori and Pakeha, it did not explain this to the rangatira. Rather, in the explanations of the texts and in the verbal assurances given by Hobson and his agents, it sought the power to control British subjects and thereby to protect Maori. That is the essence of what the rangatira agreed to.*

*This is another straight falsehood.*

*That the Waitangi Tribunal makes five statements, four of which are straight falsehoods, shows clearly the extent to which it corrupts the truth. It flagrantly dishonours the Treaty. Its abolition forthwith is a stark necessity. In other words, the basis for giving Northland to Maori is fraudulent from start to finish. The Tribunal just makes up stuff*

as a it goes along. *It's interpretation of the Treaty is just pure fantasy. It's a scam. Sadly, it's the tax payers who will pay for this.*

Memorise the Treaty. Yesterday, I was out and about, and met a Maori lady. We got into a discussion about co-governance. As you'd expect, she was for it, and I was against. I asked if she'd read the Treaty. To her credit, she was honest, and admitted she hadn't.

I wrote out the first Article of the Treaty on a piece of paper for her and asked her to tell me what she thought it said. She had little idea about the words 'cede' and 'sovereignty'. So I explained them. I would not say she was silenced, but she was sobered up. She will doubtless go and show this to all her mates. It was a reality check for her.

I asked her if she heard of Sir Apirana Ngata. She hadn't.

What this all told me was that Maori are only hearing what they see on the TV news, and in the papers, which has little (or nothing) to do with truth, and everything to do with pro-elite Maori propaganda and spin.

Below is the Treaty of Waitangi. This is the Littlewood draft, which is the final draft from which the Maori version was made. The Maori version is called Te Tiriti. The Maori version is **THE** Treaty. So if you want to know what the Maori version says, read the Littlewood draft. There are only three articles in the Treaty, and here they are.

**Article one:**

*“The chiefs of the confederation of united tribes, and the other chiefs who have not joined the confederation, cede to the Queen of England forever the entire sovereignty of their country.”*

**Article two:**

*“The Queen of England confirms and guarantees to the chiefs and the tribes and to all the people of New Zealand, the possession of their lands, dwellings and all their property. But the chiefs of the Confederation of the United Tribes and the other chiefs grant to the Queen, the exclusive rights of purchasing such lands as the proprietors thereof may be disposed to sell at such prices as may be agreed upon between them and the person appointed by the Queen to purchase from them.”*

**Article three:**

*“In return for the cession of their sovereignty to the Queen, the people of New Zealand shall be protected by the Queen of England and the rights and privileges of British subjects will be granted to them.”*
