As I said yesterday....

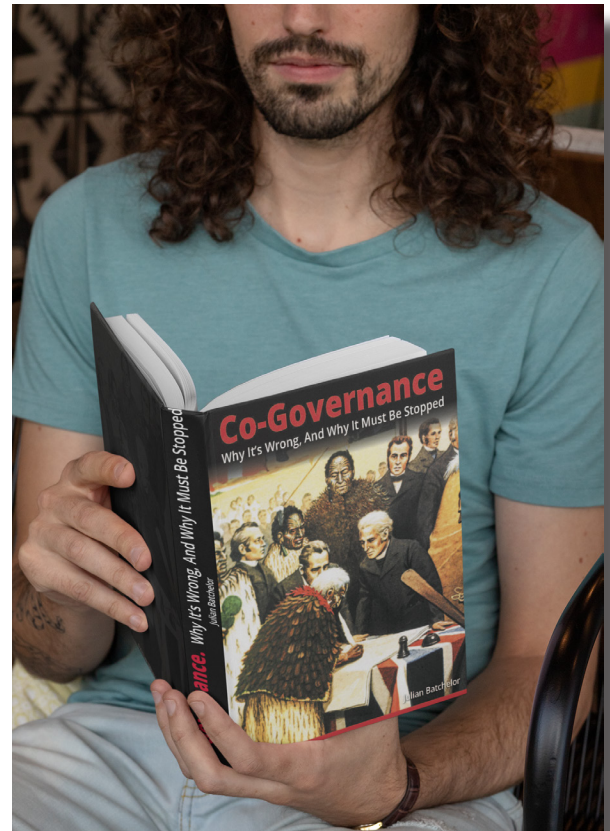
What's crucial now is that we have to work as a big team.

## **GIVING OUT BUSINESS CARDS (Latest design on right)**

*Yesterday, I was out and about in town. I saw a couple in their sixties having a coffee in the store cafe. I got eye contact, exchanged smiles, took a business card out of my pocket, then walked over to them and said **“You might be interested in this”**.*

*When they read the title of the card “Stop Co-Governance” the lady grabbed it and said “I am actually a Maori, and I am relative of Jacinda Ardern. I am so upset about what’s happening to our country. Do you have more of these cards?”*

*We chatted for a bit about co-governance. I asked for her phone number and address, and she willingly and unhesitatingly gave me the details. An hour later I dropped 100 cards to her home. They will also help with flyer delivery. I encouraged her and her husband to pass the web site details on to all her friends and people she knows via her address book on the internet.*

*The key is to be relaxed, friendly, and upbeat. Not pushy. 99% of people are very happy to receive a card and invariably thank me for doing something about co-governance. They are at a loss as to know what to do to stop it. The other key is to get their contact details so as to build your team of flyer deliverers.*

The business cards are small but extremely effective way to start. Anyone can do it. Literally anyone. You don’t even have to talk to anyone if you don’t want to. You can put them in letter boxes, or slide them in between the rubber and the glass on the driver’s door of cars in car parks.

Really, it’s terribly easy. If a lot of people did a little, say gave away five cards a day each, we’d make one heck of a big impact over time.

One cards in the hands of the right person can make a huge impact.

Today is another day. Let’s see what happens.

## OUR MISSION
