We have to get this book to every New Zealander. How? Here is a strategy. It's called RID.

THE STRATEGY

It's called the READ, INVEST, DISTRIBUTE, or "RID" for short. Yes, get RID of co-governance forever.

I am asking all Kiwis who want to stop co-governance to read the book.

Then I am asking them to invest in buying multiple copies @ \$2 each e.g. say they buy 100. Then they distribute those 100 copies into letter boxes in their neighbourhood, being careful to note what streets they actually did.

Some people might choose to not actually deliver the books themselves. Instead they will pay for books so that other can distribute them.

Others may not want to go to houses and letterboxes. Instead they will choose to keep a few copies in their bag or briefcase, and give them to people as the need arises.

Asking supporters to pay \$2 for each copy they buy means we will have funds for a reprint.

The strategy is to print 5000 initially.

It's about raising public awareness of the absolute wrongness of co-governance. Awareness is the key to change. I believe that if the average Kiwi knew the truth / facts about co-governance, they would instantly rise up to fight against it with everything in them. The reason so many are passive and seemingly non caring is that they just don't know.

We can't rely on the mainstream media to help us. In fact, they are a big part of the problem. They suppress truth, especially truth about the Treaty of Waitangi, co-governance, and the industry around it. They have been paid to do this. Conclusion? We have to get to the people directly.

My belief / hope / desire is that when those 100 books go out, 5 people in the 100 will do likewise i.e. read the book, buy some, and start distributing.

The great thing about physical books is that they can be passed around. They can sit on a coffee table or in a doctors surgery waiting room and be read multiple times. Many people prefer a book in their hand than to read one on a computer screen.

We are currently talking to a party at the moment who might co-ordinate this effort. This is a businessman and his wife who are people with means.

How will the strategy work?

For example, when person A phones / emails to order books (i.e. this person is called a distributor), our R.I.D manager (RM) will ask them what streets they will be delivering the books into. Our RM records the names of the streets on an excel spreadsheet. Let's say the street person A is delivering to is John Street, Taupo.

Our RM records John Street Taupo on her excel spread sheet.

If John Street in Taupo has already been done, our RM will ask the distributor for other alternative streets near to John Street Taupo. Once named, these will be the streets person A will distribute to.

This way, there will be no double ups. Our RM will follow this procedure for everyone who buys books.

Once person A finishes his / her distribution, she emails / phones the RM to notify him / her that distribution for John Street Taupo is complete.

It's a great plan. It will work. It's very simple and very achievable. The book is an easy read. Virtually everyone has the physical capacity put a booklet in a letter box. Virtually everyone has a few dollars to spare for a great cause. Right now, in New Zealand, there is absolutely no cause greater than stopping co-governance.

But we don't want to just reach ordinary New Zealanders. We especially want to courier a book to every:

- MP
- Mayor
- Local councilor
- School Principal
- Business leader

We just need all the people who detest co-governance so much that they will to rise up and become RID active, buying books and putting them in letter boxes.

I am asking each of the people who are getting my blog to make the time and financial sacrifice to make this happen. I am asking them to step and get the ball rolling. We have to make a start.

Nothing happens without sacrifice.

We have to be more determined to stop co-governance than the tribal representatives are to keep it going.

Only one side can win here.
