

ALL is short for Aotearoa Liberation League. They are a group of activists who are opposing Julian.

The following is a response to [a pamphlet](#) produced by the ALL to slander and denigrate Julian Batchelor.

HIS WEBSITE HAS “reviews” with stock photos, including of dead people. He uses logos, images and quotes against people’s wishes.

This is nonsense. Ask the Liberation League to provide examples where “an image or quote has been used against people’s wishes”. They won’t because they can’t.

IN HIS PRESENTATION, Julian quotes a known anti-treaty historian, Stuart C. Scott, who makes unverifiable claims that Julian further twists. First Julian quotes Scott, who makes a vague reference: “Sir Tipene O’Regan has been known to hint that if the Ngai Tahu and other c/aims ... are not met, there is a danger that Maori activists may resort to violence ... “ Julian reinterprets this, “that, folks, is a statement of war! He’s saying if we don’t get what we want, we’re going to go to war, I didn’t start this war, he did!”. This misrepresentation risks inciting fear, hatred, and violence. There are countless more examples of such fear mongering.

Stuart C. Scott has written a brilliant book on the Treaty called “The Travesty of Waitangi”. Scott is a lawyer and Historian. Everyone in my presentation and book is academically referenced so that you can see where quotes have come from. The Tipene O’Regan quote cited above is from Scott’s book.

Scott’s book was an epic work in terms of research and accuracy. It should be read by all New Zealanders.

THE \$55M JOURNALISM FUND, Julian asserts the criteria is corrupt, saying “you have to promote the Maori agenda, you have to promote co-governance and you have to promote everything that’s Maori”. Actual criteria of the fund include:

THE LITTLEWOOD DRAFT THEORY, pushed by neo-Nazi Martin Doutre and convicted rap*st and arsonist Alan Titford, says an unsigned document is somehow the real treaty. The goal is to erase the Maori right to self-governance. However, Te Tiriti o Waitangi is the document which was signed, and it’s easily accessible online. It says Maori have tino rangatiratanga over their people. Tino rangatiratanga means sovereignty.

The Littlewood Draft is accepted by an impressive array of academics as the final draft from which the Treaty in Maori was made. As for it not being signed? One doesn’t sign a draft! Doh!

The so called “Treaty document” which the ALL cite, which is signed by Hobson, is the James Freeman Rogue version of the Treaty. It varies considerably from the Treaty in Maori which is how historians know it was not the final English draft used to construct the Treaty in Maori. Just Google ‘The James Freeman Treaty Version’ and you will read about how it came to be accepted as ‘the’ Treaty by activists. Bruce Moon is the best source to investigate. If you Google ‘Tross Publishing’ choose the book ‘Twisting the Treaty’. In this book, academics discuss the James Freeman version at length and why activists (wrongly) pounced on it. In you read the on line version of Julian’s book on co-governance, there are hyperlinks available which give the reader must more detail about the fake and spurious James Freeman version of the Treaty.

GOOD FAITH DISCUSSIONS

It's important we discuss topics like co-governance. But it should come from an evidence-based and good-faith position where the goal is to create a better Aotearoa. Whatever our political outcomes, let us not use racism, exaggerations and fear to make our point.

The ALL try to come across as grounded and reasonable, but really they are not. This pamphlet is an example. The truth of the matter is that Julian in his book and his presentation just presents facts. It's the ALL that is creating fear. They are in fact, the racists, demanding special privilege and favour for Maori. The ALL are doing all they can to twist the discussion to make it about Julian being a racist. The truth? Julian is fighting *against* racism, racial division, and apartheid and *for* equality. Anyone who has attended Julian's seminar will attest to the fact that he is not a racist.

WHO IS JULIAN BATCHELOR?

He's an evangelist millionaire, a member of NZ First and an ex real-estate agent. He has his own publishing company and wrote 30 books on evangelism, filled with themes of hell, war and the devil. He campaigned against gay parades & showed anti-gay hate videos to kids as young as 10. He has degrees in psychology and theology but no experience in Maoridom.

He purchased a 140yo coastal lodge (Oke Bay Lodge) on what used to be a Maori settlement, with locals still using an old path to a cemetery. He has been disrespectful to local hapu, like by cutting a beloved old Pohutukawa without discussing it, writing a negative book and biogs about their people & more.

The property Julian owns in the Bay of Islands, the one which Maori have tried to force Julian off, is valuable, probably in the vicinity of \$6m. If by millionaire, you mean someone whose income is \$1m annually, no, Julian is not a millionaire (if only). If by millionaire you mean someone whose net worth is over \$1m, then yes, Julian is a millionaire. This property represents Julian's life savings, paying for it after decades of hard work and toil, and being frugal. Julian directed a Christian Charity for 25 years earning no more than \$25k a year so his money was not made from Christianity. In his early years, Julian was wise and invested in property, buying his first house at 22 years of age. This is how he made the money to purchase the land at Oke Bay. He invested wisely over a long period of time. Anyone who has made money from property understands how Julian would have leveraged off one property to buy another, and then off two properties to buy another, and so on.

The truth of the matter is that Maori in Rawhiti have behaved disgracefully towards Julian for 14 years. He has had to endure intense bullying, intimidation, threats and harassment, stonewalling all those years. Even extortion is not off limits for Maori in Rawhiti. All because local Maori want his land for free, especially since the Lodge on the property has been restored.

Re: being a real estate agent. Julian is actually a school teacher. When he purchased Oke Bay Lodge, it was a derelict building. He and a team of others spend 14 years restoring it. It has been a labour of love.

Julian took up work as a real estate agent so that he would have the time and flexibility to restore the Lodge. Also the income.

Re: being a member of NZ First. Yes, this is true. Julian has also been a member of the National Party and Act Parties as well. He changes who he votes for depending on their policies, election to election. In his stop co-governance seminars, he is careful not to promote any party. He is attacking one issue only, which is co-governance, an issue which he wants all parties to address and expunge. He views this issue as the most serious New Zealand has faced since 1840.

Re: owning a publishing company. No, this is not true. When Julian was a real estate agent, he started a magazine called "The Henderson Heights Community News" as part of my work as a real estate agent. Re: Publishing books on evangelism. Yes, many books. Julian traveled the world for 25 years teaching leaders in mainstream church like Anglicans, Baptists, Presbyterians about evangelism. You can see one of his books [here](#) on Amazon. Are the books filled with themes of war, hell, and the devil? No, no more so than the Bible itself. The ALL is putting a spin on Julian's books to suit their purpose. The truth of the matter is this - Kiwis are grateful that Julian is now using his highly trained mind and skills, honed all over the world, in writing and speaking, to help all Kiwis expunge co-governance from their country. We ought to be deeply grateful to him. Shame on the ALL for peppering their writing with a mixture of lies and half truths about Julian, all the purpose of publicly slandering him.

Re: campaigning against the Hero parade. Yes, Julian campaigned against the Hero Parade in the 1990s. He still believes today that homosexuality is wrong, and cross grains God's design. As for showing *anti-gay hate videos to kids as young as 10?* We asked the ALL to produce evidence of this, and all we got was silence. Why? Because no such videos exist. The ALL has outright lied about this. We encourage you to write to them too.

Re: His degrees. Yes, Julian has a Masters Degree in Psychology with honors, and a Bachelor of Theology degree, as well as being a trained teacher. He was a Massey university scholar i.e. one of the top students in the University in his years of study. As for Julian having no experience of Maoridom? No, this is not true. Julian has lived in one of the most staunch Maori communities in New Zealand for 14 years and thus has experienced tribal rule, first hand. He has suffered deeply at the hands of Maori over a prolonged period of time. Really, he has suffered on behalf of all New Zealanders so that he can warn them about what is coming and about the terror of tribal rule.

He, as well as anyone, knows about Maoridom. There is nothing quite like first hand experience. Most kiwis are oblivious as to what is just around the corner with respect to tribal rule. Most kiwis have not experienced tribal rule. Julian has, and he's touring to tell us about it, warning New Zealanders.

Re: Julian being disrespectful to Maori and chopping down a beloved Pohutukawa tree. This is laughable. Julian has acted impeccably towards Maori in spite of their prolonged and disgraceful attacks on him. He has planted over 600 native trees in 14 years, and is a keen landscaper, conservationist, and gardener. Really, the ALL ought to be ashamed of themselves for telling such whopping lies about Julian. Seriously, what they have written and published is shameful. Really, the ALL is simply demonstrating more bad Maori behaviour, giving further evidence as to why co-governance is so wrong.

RACISM

The "Stop Co-governance" tour is a thinly veiled vehicle to spread racist propaganda. This is what Julian said

about the period between Maori arriving in NZ and British colonisation:

“The rest of the world in those 600 years was inventing and developing... But not Maori. Something was wrong with Maori. They were different. This issue has never been addressed in NZ. It’s never been allowed to be discussed. Until now. Until the Stop Co-Governance Road Show.”

Anyone who has been to one of Julian’s road show events will tell you clearly he is not a racist. So what is the ALL trying to do here? They want to deflect their audience away from the real issues, the important issues, the issue of the elite Maori takeover of New Zealand, and on to trivia. What they have quoted here is trivia.

BIG CLAIMS, NO EVIDENCE

In absence of evidence Julian relies on manipulation and fear. The ‘New Zealand Center for Political Research’ is his main source of info, a millionaire funded extremist website, run and supported by ex-ACT MPs.

The website has published and supported the writings of holocaust deniers, neo-Nazis and conspiracy theorists, and validated the theory that NZ was first settled by peaceful white people who created an advanced civilization but were wiped out by Maori.

NZCPR push against wealth taxes, climate change measures and “treatyism”, a topic they are especially concerned with. They warn of a “tribal takeover” by an “elite Maori” working with governments, universities and the media. In 2015 they mimicked the ‘Iwi vs Kiwi’ campaign to create fear of “Maori control of freshwater”.

Meanwhile, NZCPR fights against regulating the corporations destroying our waterways.

Everything Julian writes or says is properly academically referenced. The NZCPR is a highly reputable source of truth for all Kiwis. Go to their web site and check them out for yourself.

MAORI TAKEOVER?

Julian misrepresents Maori leaders, who advocate for Maori to be able to govern themselves - not anyone else. The idea that a Maori ‘tribal elite’ are at ‘war’ with everyday people is demonstrably false. NZ has 14 billionaires ... and not one of them are Maori. No Maori even comes close.

The reason there are no Maori billionaires is self evident. Everyone in New Zealand has equal opportunity. This comment by the ALL betrays a victim mentality, which is all too prevalent among Maori. Somehow they think that they are simply entitled to wealth. Billionaires don’t become so without a lot of hard work.

Julian says “we’ve become the biggest proponents of apartheid” and that we have “North Korean style” media. He warns of “Maorification” and makes analogies to 9/11 and Nazi Germany. His goal is to create fear around co-governance and trigger a negative emotion while talking about Maori issues.

Anyone with an IQ over room temperature, who is even slightly in touch with reality, will observe that our media is corrupt, and that co-governance is not about co-governance at all. Rather, it’s code for tribal takeover and eventually full blown tribal rule. Read closely the definition on the right above. The truth of the matter? When Kiwis fully understand what is going on with respect to so called ‘co-governance’ it will trigger negative emotions, including fear and horror. To feel these emotions is good and right. They are warnings, like a red light coming on on the dashboard of a car.

TREATY SETTLEMENTS

Often cited as an example of privilege, the treaty settlement process was unilaterally set up by the crown de-

spite vehement opposition from Maori. Research shows this process has “traumatized claimants, divided their communities, and returned on average less than one percent of their stolen lands” (Margaret Mutu). The total value of settlements since 1995 is \$2.7 billion. To put that into perspective, the crown makes over a \$100 billion a year, NZ’s richest person is worth \$17 billion, and we lose up to \$2 billion to tax fraud annually. While many Maori are left struggling without land or compensation, Julian is a millionaire who profits from a coastal lodge on an old Maori settlement, complaining about having lands stolen from him. Perhaps some projection going on.

The section is a litany of lies. First, Maori had sold 90% of the landmass of NZ by 1865. Their land was not ‘stolen’. It was sold by them.

Dr Muriel Newman [writes](#) “Tribes did not “lose” land. Tribes sold 24.13-million hectares of New Zealand’s total land area of 26.8-million hectares for substantial amounts of money. Claims about land sales before 1840, about sales between 1840 and 1865, and sales through the Native Land Court, are merely claims for more money for those old sales.”

If Maori are “left struggling without land”, whose fault is this?

This is emotional clap trap. They sold it. Sometimes the same piece of land was sold 3 or 4 times to different buyers on the same day.

Writes historian Mike Butler “Most grievances had been settled by 1960 on a full-and-final basis and that should have been the end of the story.”¹

What they are experiencing is sellers remorse i.e. they regretted selling. But this is a fact of life. All people of all cultures make bad decisions, including selling property then regretting it, and they have to live with the consequences. At the time of sale, they wanted the money more than they wanted the land.

Maori have to come to this realisation about their situation, and be mature about it.

When they say “Research shows....”. What research? Where is this research? When asked about this, all we get is silence. Why? Because the research does not exist.
