TAKE THE SURVEY

ACT's focus this week is on crime,

Last month when we asked you what your priorities were, **crime was ranked third** behind co-governance and the cost-of-living. It's an issue that's not just on your mind, **it's on the minds of all decent New Zealanders.**

In last week's survey, **84%** of respondents said they didn't feel "Very Safe" - **we think this is simply unacceptable** - every New Zealander deserves to feel safe in their home, workplace, and in their community.

ACT says we need to get tougher on crime, and smarter on the causes of crime. **There must be swiftly-enforced consequences** to get our worst repeat offenders off the street. Once in prison there must be an emphasis on rehabilitation to **break**

the cycle of people leaving prison unable to read and write with no option but to re-enter the criminal economy.

Getting tougher and smarter on crime is the only way we can **put an end to the culture of lawlessness which Labour has allowed to creep into New Zealand.** ACT's vision is for a country where parents aren't afraid for their kids to leave the house, and where adults aren't afraid to walk the city streets at night.
